Can We Lose Our Salvation?

Hebrews 6:1-12

Sermon Sketch: In one of the hardest questions in our series, I proudly sit myself on the fence and say, “Yes and no...”

- 1) How have you sought to live in the fulness of Jesus in the past week?, (Was Our Salvation the Only Reason Jesus Came? 4/23/23)
- 2) Have you ever known someone well who seemed to walk very closely to the Savior and then seemingly fell away?
- 3) What do you remember especially about being “enlightened” (4) when you first came to faith in Jesus? How has God continued to pour light into your soul as you have walked with Him?
- 4) How do the verses (John 10:27-30, Romans 8:38-39, Philippians 1:6, and 2 Timothy 1:12) about God’s preserving power in our lives give you great comfort?
- 5) How do the verses (Matthew 24:4, 11-13, 1 Corinthians 10:12, and Colossians 1:21-23a) with warnings of falling away encourage you to press deeper into the things of God?
- 6) If you were to embrace the theological conviction that a believer can possibly turn away from Christ, how might you maintain your confidence in your own personal salvation (John 5:24, 1 John 5:11-13)?
- 7) Does it make sense to you to pray like it all depends upon God and to live like it all depends upon you? How might you integrate the human and divine elements in Philippians 2:12-13?
- 8) How comfortable are you living in the tension of two of the many great realities in Scripture: God is sovereign and humanity must face up to their personal responsibility?
- 9) How might you trust God’s sovereignty in a greater way in the week ahead?
- 10) What might you do to seek to live out His glory in your thoughts/words/deeds in the week ahead?
- 11) How can you pray for your brothers and sisters in Christ who are seeking to do the same?
