Remembering the Lord Our Maker Isaiah 51 May 7, 2023

Sermon Sketch: Returning to the series on Isaiah we find God speaking through His prophet to remind us to trust fully in Him because He is the all-powerful Creator....

- How have you sought to live out your faith in the past week? (Hebrews 6 – Can We Lose Our Salvation – Enquiring Minds 10)
- 2) Do you have a great memory or is your memory like a sieve (a phrase my parents used)?
- 3) The serious challenge to be keenly aware (Listen-1, 4, Hear- 4, 7, 21, and Lift up eyes, look- 6) of what God has done and is doing runs throughout this chapter. How aware do you feel you are with regard to God's workings in your life? How might you be intentional in listening/hearing/looking towards God?
- 4) The command to remember was stated four times (Isaiah 17:10, 44:21, 46:8 and 46:9) prior to this chapter's challenge to "not forget". Additionally, there are probably 40 other Scriptures (Old and New Testament) that call us to remember. All this Biblical data makes it clear that calling to mind God's goodness and character are critical. What are you going to do about that? What might become a daily habit of remembrance (Lamentations 3:21, Matthew 6:11)? What might serve as a physical

reminder of God's goodness in your life (Joshua 4:1-7)

- 5) As Communion rolls around each month how do remember Christ in the Bread? How do you remember Christ in the Cup?
- 6) How will you plan on remembering your Maker daily in the week ahead?
