

Proclaiming the Reign of Our King Isaiah 52

Sermon Sketch: It is a beautiful thing to shout aloud the rule of our amazing God. We need to tell each other, and tell the world – “The Lord Reigns!!!!!!!!!!!!!!”

- 1) How did recalling daily that Jesus was your Maker/Creator change your week? (Isaiah 51 – Remembering the Lord Our Maker – May 7, 2023)
- 2) Whose “beautiful feet” (7) brought the proclamation of Jesus’ salvation into your life?
- 3) Romans 10:5-17 makes a logical case for our need to be “proclaimers”. Are you convinced by Paul’s argument there? If faith comes by hearing (Rom. 10:17) and they can’t hear unless they are preached to (10:14) then doesn’t that mean we all are to be the preachers?
- 4) Have you ever had the opportunity to be “beautiful feet” in someone else’s life? – The answer is yes. At some point in your life you had a chance to witness for Jesus- whether you realized it or not. Have you ever seized that opportunity and verbally shared your faith with someone? What might you do to grow in your comfort level in sharing the Gospel verbally with someone?
- 5) Are you more comfortable with friendship evangelism or contact evangelism? How might you mix the two?
- 6) Are you more comfortable speaking the Gospel (proclamation) or demonstrating the Gospel (service)? How should the two be intertwined?
- 7) Have you ever used tracts like “Steps to Peace with God”, outlines like the Roman Road, or the verses from the Navigator’s Topical Memory System to share the great news of Jesus with someone who was seeking?
- 8) If the Church were to offer “Share Jesus without Fear” or “Evangelism Explosion” or a similar training would you be willing to participate? If so, could you email the Church Office making your interest known?
- 9) Alliance Core Value #1 states “Lost people matter to God. He wants them found” (Luke 19:10). What does that mean for your life?
- 10) How does the fact that you are an ambassador/witness/proclaimer for Christ give significance to your existence on this planet?
- 11) How might you pray more intensely about this topic in the week ahead? How might you expect the Holy Spirit to move in your life with regard to this issue?
