Sermon Sketch: God gives us everything. When we give, we are returning to Him but a small portion of His own. Giving frees us from the tyranny of "stuff"

How has God been faithful to, as Paul says, "And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19)?
- 5) Beyond financial supporting the Kingdom building effort in our world today, how are you using your time and talent to advance the cause of Christ on the earth today?

- 6) Have you ever considered "tithing" your time to the Lord? For example, if you work a 40-hour work week, could you give 4 hours a week to ministry efforts?
- 7) With billions of dollars spent every year to entice you to a life of ceaseless consumerism how do you fight the tug of the world?
- 8) How do you seek to emulate Paul who said of himself, "Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content." (Philippians 4:11) and who taught "But godliness with contentment is great gain," (1 Timothy 6:6)?
- 9) How does the realization that God really owns everything you have in your possession change your perspective on your "stuff"? How does "giving hilariously" set you free from the tyranny of materialism?
- 10) What offering will you lift to the Lord in the week ahead (Romans 12:1)?
