Sermon Sketch: We all need a Savior – God has given us Jesus. If you already believe – re-embrace Him as King. If not, accept Jesus as Savior today...

- 5) We were saved "to" many things: Holiness 1 Thess.
  3:12-13, God's peace John 14:27, Wholeness 1 Thess. 5:23 and a Purpose beyond ourselves Phil.
  1:21-22. What would you add to that list?
- 6) How did the illustration from the life of Booth Tucker impact you? Have you been able to experience the

sufficiency of Christ when you have faced trials and tribulations?

- 7) For as many Christmases you have celebrated, how does the fact that Jesus came to be your Savior impact you freshly every year?
- 8) How does the wonder of Jesus being your Savior everyday encourage you to share Him with others around you?
- 9) As your DNA has shaped who you presently are and who you will become how will Jesus as your Savior shape you in the week ahead? Through the next year? Over the course of the next five years?
- 10) Who are you actively praying for to come to know Jesus as Savior?
