Scriptures Greatest Hits #2 Trusting With All Our Hearts Proverbs 3:5-6

Sermon Sketch: The greatest hit today brings us to a Proverb that promises God's guidance (a wonderful facet from last week's study of Psalm 23) if we trust the Lord with all our heart...

- How have you enjoyed Jesus' shepherding over your life this past week? How have you chosen to be a person of praise? (Scriptures Greatest Hits #1 – God our Shepherd, Psalm 23 1/28/ 24)
- 2) Are you a fairly trusting person in your human relationships or do you have issues with that?
- 3) How trusting are you of God (Psalm 9:10, 20:7, 22:4-5, 28:7, 37:3&5, 44:6)? How has He shown Himself faithful to you, and thereby proven Himself to be worthy of your trust? Have there been life circumstances or seemingly unanswered prayer that have cause you to ever call into question His trustworthiness?
- 4) In what ways have you been able to give over your whole heart to Jesus? In what ways are you holding back? How do the words of Scripture challenge you to go "all in" with God (Deuteronomy 4:29, 6:5, 10:12 and Luke 10:27)?
- 5) Who or what do you especially lean on in life? How much do you lean on your own wisdom and understanding? How has that worked for you?

- 6) How do you choose to acknowledge the rule and reign of Jesus over your life? In what ways might you broaden your acknowledgement of Christ in your life?
- 7) When people typically reference Proverbs 3 it is usually just verse 5 and 6. Verses 7 and 8 have some important instruction also. How has His goodness helped you to turn from the evil of the world (7)? How has Jesus' presence in your life brought healing to the core of your very being (8)?
- 8) How might modeling the faith walk described in these verses become a blessing to both individuals and the whole fellowship around you? Who has been a blessing in your life as they have modelled this walk with God?
