His Holiness Shared Hebrews 12:10

Sermon Sketch: God's holiness is one of the attributes of Deity that He shares with us. The blood of Jesus transforms us from broken sinners to holy children, born of His love...

- How has God's call on your life to be a disciple maker been fleshed out in the past week? (Scriptures Greatest Hits #7, Make Disciples Where Ever and Whenever You Go, Matthew 28:18-20, 2/25/24)
- 2) Has there ever been a time when you especially felt the holiness of God in your life? Have you ever reacted to that holiness like Isaiah did (Isa. 6:1-7)? Or like Peter did (Luke 5:1-11)? Why might God's holiness engender such a response?
- 3) Only four of the many verses about God's holiness (Exodus 15:11, Leviticus 11:44-45, Psalm 22:3 and 99:9) were referenced in the sermon. What other Scriptures come to your mind as you think about God being holy?
- 4) The word "share" in Hebrews 12:10 is a strong word: aggressively take or receive. What active role are you taking in receiving God's holiness in to your life? What posture or attitude might you assume in order to more fully experience His holiness in your life?

- 5) How are you pursuing (2 Corinthians 7:1, Ephesians 4:24, 1 Thessalonians 4:4,7; Hebrews 12:14, and 2 Peter 3:11) holiness in your life? How might the Holy Spirit help you in that pursuit?
- Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness,
- 7) What encouragement is there for you, knowing that God is actively seeking to bring forth holiness in your inner being (Leviticus 21:8 and 1 Thessalonians 3:13)?
- 8) How might we be a presence of holiness in an unholy world (1 Corinthians 5:6-8 and 2 Corinthians 2:14) without being obnoxious or off-putting?
- 9) How might you wear God's holiness like a crown (Exodus 28:36)? How might God's holiness affect not only your thought life, but every area of your existence?
